Update - Local Plan (Core Strategy) 5 Year Review

Public Consultation on the 5 Year Review of the Core Strategy will commence next week and a series of public events, displays and presentations will be conducted throughout the District. The consultation is due to start on the **26th October and run until 18th December**.
