

South Western Housing Society development at Northwick Road

The work on building out 12 affordable homes for people with a local connection to the village is progressing well. The builder, E G Carter, has been working on the 'off site' works for the development since Christmas and this is set to continue for the next few weeks. This is the work required to connect drains and services to the new homes in readiness for the main structures to begin being constructed.

This work has required extensive liaison with the statutory authorities and has included necessary road closures. The builder continues to liaise with local residents affected and with the aim of achieving the minimum amount of disruption as possible.

Our contractor has signed up for the Considerate Constructor Scheme, which monitors site safety, contractor courtesy and engagement with the local village.

The Society has begun to receive enquiries regarding the properties. Whilst it is too soon to begin the allocation process, should anybody wish to express an interest and discuss the criteria for letting in more detail, please do not hesitate to contact the business support team at the society on customerservices@swhs.org.uk and they will put you in touch with an officer who can explain this to you.

We continue to try to ensure that no problems arise for villagers, though understand that the nature of construction can inevitably lead to some queries or concerns.
